

RULES
BOWDON DUCK FEST ART SHOW-OCTOBER 8 AND 9, 2010
BOWDON COMMUNITY GYMNASIUM
BOWDON, NORTH DAKOTA

1. Artists may enter any age of work, any subject of work, any number of works. Entry forms must be received before September 30, 2010, and a \$3.00 per regular sized piece or \$1.00 per miniature piece fee must accompany the entry form. Make checks payable to Bowdon Duck Fest Art Show. Late work will be displayed but not published in program.
2. Each piece must be signed, original work. No unsigned work will be accepted.
3. All work needs to be display-ready. We prefer wire hanging, but any hangers must be secure. If displaying an unusual piece, please provide your own easel or stand if possible. Artwork must be able to fit through a 36" doorway.
4. To be considered as a series, pieces must be variations of the same subject, media and coloration. Size must be similar or in a congruent configuration, with matting and framing the same.
5. All subjects will be considered for display, but each must be discreet and suitable for family viewing.
6. All work must be identified with the title, name of the artist, and outside dimensions.
7. Designate either the purchase price or NFS (not for sale) for each piece. The committee will act as brokers; collecting payment for pieces sold during the show with NO commission charged to the artist. However, purchased work will not be allowed to be removed from the show until check-out time. Distribution of purchase funds will be made to the artists at that time.
8. Setup will be Friday morning, October 8, 2010 from 7am to 11am. All entries must be delivered into the hands of the committee at the Bowdon Community Gymnasium during that time period. Artists may delegate someone to deliver their work if they cannot do so in person. Mailing art work to an Art Show Chairman will also be permitted. Art work may be mailed back as well just include postage for the returning art work. Art work, both sold and unsold, may be picked up beginning at 5pm and ending promptly at 6pm Saturday, October 9, 2010. (We need to expedite the removal of art pieces, because another event is scheduled for 7pm that evening in the exhibition area.)
*Note: Pieces will be released only to the artist, an artist-authorized delegate, or purchaser presenting a valid receipt. Sold pieces may be sent by mail at the purchasers expense.
9. Every effort will be made to protect the art pieces and handle them with care. However, Duck Fest will not be responsible for insurance coverage, loss, theft, or damage of any work. Items must be appraised and insured at the artist's expense.
